

REPORT ON DISTRIBUTION RICE AND FOODS SEPTEMBER 30, 2013

Pioneering Partner in Cambodia (PPC), Bright Future Program is one of PPC’s projects/programs which working based on child sponsorship in education. There are 90 children were receiving sponsorship start from April, 2010 – September 30, 2013.

PPC Executive Director (ED) contacted Mercy Outreach Coordinator (Ms. Debbie) from ST BRIGID'S College & Mercy College from Australia. In the first communication she agreed to transfer USD 1,500 (US Dollars one thousand five hundred only) for victims affected by flood. PPC ED shared this to couple of friend in USA, they shared their love by transferring US\$ 425 to contribute to the program.



PPC called the committee (PPC-BFP, local Church and River of Life school) to start prepare the program of distribution. The committee calculated 90 families will be received the rice. PPC ED met ST BRIGIDS College coordinator at Sunway Hotel, she added USD 200 more for lunch of 168 children. ED shared an idea of supporting PPC-BFP overhead costs through Focus Cambodia, she promised to raise funds to support the program and arrange a meeting with Director of Focus Cambodia.



At PPC office, PPC-BFP presented to the team of 33 students/teachers from ST BRIGID'S and MERCY College, 100% interested in child sponsorship, each college wanted to support one child yearly, they will confirm PPC after they got approval from their parents. PPC-BFP gave them sponsor form each student. However, at the moment a college student decided and gave money to support one child for one year. The Board of ST BRIGID'S College sent US\$ 890 (US Dollars Eight hundred and ninety only) for buying land for additional classes. Also they offered US\$ 500 for PPC-BFP overhead costs and some amount for PPC-BFP staff. The team promised to transfer some amount for additional classes.

The group entered the villages and divided into 2 groups, one group distributed Rice and Foods to 125 families whom affected by flood and other one came up with children activities by played games, drawing pictures etc. They enjoyed with sharing love to the villagers and children and took a lot of pictures. After distribution and children activities all participants had lunch together with around 250 people included children, teachers, villagers, PPC team, Church members and Australian team.



The program was done and finished at 2:15 pm, the Australian team left first and gave some school materials, children cloth, shoes etc. to PPC, PPC will keep all things for 2 different PPC-BFP areas. The team promised to contact PPC again next year when they come to Cambodia.
